Does the report meet the requirements of the task? ; #61548 ; Does it describe the whole graph adequately? ; effect, argument and discussion Causes ; b. causes (2) ; c. effects (2) ; d. solutions (2) ; a. Introduction ; b. advantages (2) ; c. disadvantages (2) ; d. conclusion In IELTS test, there are not such difference between argument and discussion essay, just follow the strategies above. To show your own opinion at the end of the argument essay. NOTICE: Each paragraph you should have TS (topic sentence), SS (supporting sentence) and DS (developing sentence) to make up your essay.
