W ithout information regarding the way in which the protesting studentswere Oselected，it ispresumptuousto conclude that their opinionsfail to reflect the opinions of their colleagues Second，the author citesthe fact that the remaining 12，000 studentsstayed on campusor left for winter break asevidence that they are not concerned about their education．O ne obviousrejoinder to thisline of reasoning isthat the sudentswho did not participate did so with the knowledge that their concernswould be expresed by the protesting students．In any caæe，the author hasfailed to demonstrate alogical connection between the students＇alleged lack of concern and the fact that they either stayed on campusor left for winter break． Without thisconnection，the conclusion reached by the author that the remaining 12,000 studentsare not concerned about their education is unacceptable．A sit stands，the argument isnot well reasoned．To make it logically acceptable，the author would have to demonstrate that the protesting studentshad some characteristic in common that biasestheir views，thereby nullifying their protest as representative of the entire college．100T est 下载频道开通，各类考试题目直接下载。详细请访问 www．100test．com
