fo/owing isthe best title for the article?0 ther overview questionsask about the writer of the passage, the readers of the passage, or the place of publication: In what business isthe writer of the passoge? What isthe authorsopinion of $\qquad$ ?W ho would be most interested in the information in thisannouncement?For whom is thisadvertisement intended?W here wasthisarticle probably published?* Detail questions, the most common type of Part V II question, akk about specific pointsin the passage. You will usually have to scan the passoge to find and identify the information. Sometimesthe answer and the information in the passge do not look the same. For example, asentence in a passage may read "This processisnot assimple asit oncewas" The correct answer may be "The processisnow more complex."Some detail questionsare negative questions These almost alwaysinclude the word NOT, which isprinted in uppercaæe (capital) lettersBaeed on the information in the passage, which of the following isNOT true?N egative questionsusually take longer to answer than other detail questions*A few questionsin Part V II are inferencequestions. The answersto these questionsare not directly stated in the passge. Instead, you must draw a conclusion about the information that is given. Sometypical inference questions W hich of theee statements is probably true?W hich of the following can be inferred from this notice?A nswer ChoicesA II arebelievable answersto the questions. Incorrect choices often contain information that ispresented somewhere in the passge but doesnot correctly answer the question.A Note About V ocabularyM ost of the vocabulary in the
