It consists of a balance sheet and an income statement (also called a profit and loss statement or "Pamp.L which shows the results of operations over a period of time. It lists the assets of the company on the left side and liabilities on the right side. When a company is solvent its assets exceed its liabilities, and that figure, called the net worth of the company, also appears on the right side of a balance sheet. The basic components of a P&amp.L statement are money received from sales and other sources along with the amount paid out for expenses, taxes, and other costs. The difference between the two is called the " bottom line."
