Money by itself gives us no benefit -- only by spending it can we obtain the thing we want. 货币本身不能给我们带来任何好处 惟有将货币投入使用，我们才能获得所需的物品。(1)by itself: 独自地，单独地(2) -- only by spending it can we obtain the thing we want.这是由only引出的倒装句，起强调语气的作用，其正常语序为：-- we can obtain the thing (that) we want only by spending it.5. Without some form of money in circulation, the range of goods and services available to us would be considerably reduced and business transactions would be difficult to

carry on. 如果没有某种流通货币，可供我们使用的货物和劳务的范围将大大缩小，交易也难以进行。(1)本句运用了与现在事实相反的虚拟语气，“without some form of money in circulation”是介词短语，起假设条件从句的作用，相当于：“if there were not some form money in circulation”。(2)“to carry on”是主动形式表示被动意思。在某些结构中，不定式虽然表示被动的意思，用的却是主动形式。如：He has no one to take care of. We still have many difficulties to overcome.

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
