referred to as bills, are essentially a short term credit instrument that can be used by a company either for financing or investment. bills can be issued for any term up to a year and are generally issued for periods of less than 6 months. companies issue bills because they are a convenient form of borrowing. the difference between bills and a standard loan is that bills held by the bank can sold to investors. bills
