No, Im not. (没有，我是认真的。)

Youre joking! Youre pulling my leg! *用pull...leg表示“嘲弄人”。

No kidding! That cant be! Youve got to be kidding! 怎么可能!

It cant be! *不相信所降氛虑

It cant be! (怎么可能!) That cant be! It cant be true!

Impossible! (不可能!) 当真?/你肯定? Are you serious? Lets go to

Europe this summer! (今年夏天我们去欧洲吧!) Are you serious? (

当真?/你肯定?) Seriously? 那真的很重要! Thats really something!

*something 在口语中表示“重要的东西”。 哎呀!/吓死人了。

Oh, my! I was in a car accident. (我碰上交通事故了。)

Oh, my! (哎呀!) My God. *God是宗教用语，一般不能随便挂在嘴边。

Good grief! *表示吃惊或沮丧的情绪。“惊呆了，难以置信，

怎么回事儿呀!”。 He failed another test. (他又没考上。) Good grief! (是吗?真不像话。) 哎呀呀! Well, well. Oh, my! Oh, boy! Gee! *俚语。 My goodness! Oh, dear! *特别是女性比较喜欢用。 Dear! Dear! Good gracious! Oh, brother! 你吓死我了。 You surprised me! Boo! (啊-!) You surprised me! (你吓死我了。) You scared me. What a surprise! 这怎么可能呢? You dont say! *一种吃惊、感叹和讽刺的说法。 I really do love you. (我真的爱你。) You dont say! (唉, 不会吧!) 永远不可能有那样的事! Thatll be the day! *表示“怎么可能!岂有此理!” Im going to marry you. (我要和你结婚。) Thatll be the day! (永远不可能有那样的事!) Itll never happen! Impossible! Ill believe that when I see it. (眼见为实。) Ill believe that when it happens. (只有发生了的事我才相信。) 震惊。 A great shock. A big shock. Thats a shocker. 第一次听说。 Thats news to me. Theres a meeting today at 5 00. (今天五点开会。) Thats news to me. (我刚听说。) Thats the first Ive heard of it. (我第一次听说。) 令人难以想像! Its mind-boggling! * “mind-boggling” 表示类似“不可能是真的!大吃一惊!无法相信”。 I never knew he was so rich. (我从来不知道他那么有钱。) I know, its mind-boggling, isnt it? (他很有钱, 这简直让人不敢相信, 是吧?) It blew me away. 糟了! Gosh! *表示吃惊, 带有“哎呀, 不得了了”的语感。 Gosh! Ive overslept again! (糟了! 又睡过了!) No, not again! (没有, 没到点呢!) 那条消息真让人吃惊。 We were surprised by the news. *news “新闻, 消息”。哇! Boo! * “哇!”、“啊”, 吓唬人。 Boo! (哇!) That wasnt funny. (一点也不好玩!)
