This construction does not exist in English, where you would use the present perfect tense. Here are a few examples: Leggo questo libro da una settimana. (I've been reading this book for a week.) Prendiamo lezioni di italiano da molti mesi. (We've been taking Italian lessons for many months.) To ask how long something has been going on, use da quanto tempo present-tense verb: Da quanto tempo leggi questa rivista? (How long have you been reading this magazine?)
