indicate a quality or indefinite quantity and come with specific nouns. The most common forms are *che* (what? what kind of?), *quale* (which?), and *quanto* (how much? how many?). For example: *Quali parole ricordi?* (Which words do you remember?) *Che libri leggete?* (What books do you read?) *Quante ragazze vengono?* (How many girls are coming?) *Che ora è?* (What time is it?) *Quanto pane vuoi?* (How much bread do you want?) Notice the difference in meaning between *che* and *quale*. The question *Quali film hai visto?* asks "Which films have you seen?" (For example, *Il Postino*, *Ciao Professore!* or *La Vita è Bella*.) The question *Che film hai visto?* asks "What types of films have you seen?" (For example, comedy, romance, or thriller.) The interrogative adjective *quanto* (how many, how much) agrees in number and gender with the noun it modifies and has four forms (see table below). **FOUR FORMS OF QUANTO? (HOW MUCH?/HOW**

MANY?masculine/singular*quanto**Quanto tempo fa?* (How long ago?)
masculine/plural*quanti**Quanti anni hai?* (How old are you?)
feminine/singular*quanta**Quanta farina c'è?* (How much flour is there?)
