selling a single book.Y ou have to becareful not to be attracted by the variety of booksin abookshop. It isvery easy to enter the shop looking for abook on, say, ancient coinsand to come out carrying a copy of the latest best- selling novel and perhapsabook about brass rubbing- something which had only vaguely interested you up till then. Thisvolume on the subject, however, happened to be so well illustrated and the part of the text you read proved so interesting, that you just had to buy it. Thissort of thing can bevery dangerous.
