https／／www．100test．com／kao＿ti2020／175／2021＿2022＿Tips＿for＿t＿c5 ＿175253．htm A nswer all questions．There isno negative marking for incorrect answers．The reading test isconsidered by many to be the most difficult part of IELTS．A nd with some justification．You have to read 3long sections，each with multiple paragraphs，and answer 40 questions（13to 14per section）．U nlikethe listening test，no extra time isgiven at theend to transfer your answersto the answer sheet． Time can be amajor constraint since you only have an hour to finish the test．Start by reading the H ow to prepare for IELTS－Reading test manual at the H ong Kong City U niversity site to familiarize yourself with the test，the types of questionsthat are akked and strategiesfor answering them．The key to doing well in thispart ispractice．Read newspapers，magazinesand books．Try and improveyour reading skillsand speed．Do the practice testsin Cambridge IELTS3．The most important thing to understand isthat the test doesNOT assess your comprehension of the paragraphs．It does NOT test how well you have understood the passage．It testsspecific skillscalled Scanning and Skimming．Scanning iswhat one does，for example， when looking for a phone number in adirectory．You know the specific information you are looking for and you go down the page quickly to find it．Thistechnique isused when answering questions such asmultiple choice and matching．You scan the passge to quickly find the information mentioned in the question．O nceyou find it，you get the answer from the passoge and write it against the
question. Skimming refersto reading a paragraph quickly to get an idea of what it isabout, without trying to understand itsdetails This technique ispart of the initial reading ( sebelow). It can be modified (reading alittle sower) to answer "Provide headingsfor the paragraphs" , "In which paragraph doesthisinformation appear in the text?' and "A uthorsviews" type of questions. The sectionsget progressively more difficult. Aim to spend about 15 to 17 minuteson Section 1, 20 minuteson Section 2 and 23 to 25 minuteson Section 3. If possible, keep some spare time to check your answers I would suggest ( and thisishow I did it) that you first read all the questions quickly to get an idea of what type of information is required and whether scanning or skimming (or acombination of the two) is called for. A syou read the questions, use a pencil to underline important information such asdates, placesand names O nceyou are through with reading all the questions, skim over the text and underline/mark important parts If you see any information relating to the questions, mark it straight away. You may even be able to answer some questionsasyou read. A nswer thequestionsone by one with the help of the underlined partsof the text. H aving read the text once, you will find it easy to find specific information by scanning. The answersusually appear in the text in the same order asthe questions. That is, the answer to question 4 will beearlier in the text than the answer to question 5 . Thisneed not alwaysbe true. It may apply to each question type rather than to all the questionstaken together. The answer to MCQ 2 will appear before that to MCQ 3 and the answer to Matching question 2will usually appear earlier
