同irritate, fester, gall

reminiscence n.回忆
同memory, remembrance, recollection
Diana shared her reminiscences of her trip around the world with me.
黛安娜和我分享她环游世界的回忆。

reverence n.尊敬
同respect, honor, adoration, veneration, worship
The memorial statue was erected in reverence of the founder of the country.
该纪念像是为景仰开国者而建立的。

sapient adj.有智慧的同wise, intelligent, sage, sagacious, knowledgeable
If you follow her sapient advice, you will be sure to succeed.

severe adj.严厉的同strict, harsh, tough, rigid
