avocation n. 副业；嗜好同diversion, hobby, occupation, pastime Louis avocation as a ski instructor gradually became his full-time employment. 滑雪教练一职已从路易斯的副业逐渐变成他的全职了。

candidate n. 候选人同nominee, office-seeker, applicant, aspirant Teresa has decided to become a candidate for mayor of our town. 特雷萨已决定作为候选人参加本镇镇长的竞选。

coagulate v. 凝结同solidify, jell, congeal, clot, curdle The blood around the wound began to coagulate, slowing the loss of blood. 伤口边的血开始凝结，减缓了血液的流失。

conceal v. 隐藏同hide, cover, secrete, stow The brothers tried to conceal the puppy from their parents, but it was soon discovered. 这几个兄弟试图把小狗藏起来不让父母看到，但不久小狗就被发现了。

contiguity n. 邻接同juxtaposition,
