flush v. 脸红 逐出
同1.blush, redden 2.eject, expel When she smiled at him, his face flushed bright red. 当她对他微笑时，他的脸涨得通红。

gallant adj. 勇敢的 同 brave, daring, courageous A gallant man jumped into the river to save the drowning child. 一名勇敢的男子跳进河里搭救那个溺水的小孩。

halt v. 停止 同 pull up, stop, pause The soldiers at the border halted the travelers to check their passports. 驻守边界的士兵把游客拦下来，检查他们的护照。

idolize v. 崇拜 同 admire, worship, adore Jackie idolizes her math teacher and wants to be just like her. 杰姬崇拜她的数学老师，想成为和她一样的人。

incessant adj. 不断的 同 continuous, constant, ceaseless, continual, everlasting The incessant barking of my neighbors dog kept me awake at night. 邻居的狗不停地叫，使我整夜无法入睡。

inordinate adj. 不节制的；过度的 同 excessive, immoderate, intemperate, exorbitant Doctors have reported an inordinate number of patients with the flu this winter. 医生们报告说今年冬天有很多人罹患流行性感冒。

jettison v. 丢弃；放弃 同 cast, throw, hurl, abandon, give up The ships captain ordered that all extra cargo be jettisoned to prevent the ship from sinking. 船长下令把所有多余的货物都扔掉，以免船只沉没。

lament v. 哀悼 同 deplore, bemoan, bewail Everyone in the neighborhood lamented the death of my Uncle Robert. 附近的每个人都对罗伯特叔叔的死表示哀悼。

luminous adj. 发光的 同 bright, radiant, shining We
