The New Middle East Oil Bonanza If the Burj Dubai development isnt the biggest project in the world, it must be close. At night under floodlights thousands of mostly Asian workers in hard hats swarm over a 500-acre building site in the heart of Dubai, the Persian Gulf emirate that is tiny in size but limitless in ambition. Emaar Properties, a local company, is carving out of the desert a new \$20 billion district with 30,000 homes, a Giorgio Armani-designed hotel, an ice rink, and a 30-acre man-made lake. The centerpiece of the project, which employs more than a dozen American firms, is Burj Dubai, a \$1 billion tower. It was designed by Chicago architects Skidmore Owings amp. Oriental Steam Navigation Co. for \$6.8 billion, agreed to take over management of several major ports, from New York to Miami. The deal has sparked an outcry among politicians worried that an Arab-owned company could be a vehicle for al Qaeda operatives.
