The reason that time isso critical isthat 1) every question countsthe same toward your final score, and 2) the passagesare not in order of difficulty. If you have to rush during the last passage, then you will missout on answering easier questionscorrectly. It isnatural to want to pause and figure out the hardest questions, but you must resist the temptation and move quickly.Pace YoursefW ear awatch to the IELTST est. At the beginning of the test, check the time ( or start a chronometer on your watch to count the minutes), and check the time after each passge or every few questionsto make sure you are " on schedule." Remember that on the Listening and Reading Modulesyou have alittle over half a minute for each question. If you can work quickly, you can pace yourself at half a minute per question, which makesit easy to keep track of your time. If you find that you are falling behind time during the test, you must speed up. Even though arushed answer ismore likely to be incorrect, it is better to missacouple of questionsby being rushed, than to completely misslater questionsby not having enough time. It is better to end with moretime than you need than to run out of time.If you are forced to speed up, do it efficiently. U sually one or more answer choicescan be eliminated without too much difficulty. A bove all, don' t panic. Don' t speed up and just begin guessing at random choices By pacing yourseff, and continually monitoring your progressagainst the clock or your watch, you will alwaysknow exactly how far ahead or behind you are with your available time. If you find that you are afew minutesbehind on amodule, don' $t$ skip questionswithout spending any time on it, just to catch back up.

Spend perhapsalittle lessthan half aminute per question and after a few questions，you will have caught back up moregradually．O nce you catch back up，you can continueworking each problem at your normal pace．If you have time at the end，go back then and finish the questionsthat you left behind．Furthermore，don＇tdwell on the problemsthat you were rushed on．If a problem wastaking up too much time and you made a hurried guess，it must have been difficult． The difficult questionsare the onesyou are mos likely to miss anyway，so it isn＇t abig loss If you have time left over，asyou review the skipped questions，start at the earliest skipped question， spend at most another half a minute，and then move on to the next skipped question．Lastly，sometimesit isbeneficial to sow down if you are constantly getting ahead of time．You are alwaysmore likely to catch a carelessmistake by working more sowly than quickly，and among very high－scoring test takers（thoæe who are likely to have lots of time left over），carelesserrors affect the score more than mastery of material．ScanningFor Reading passoges，don＇twaste time reading，enjoying，and completely understanding the passage．Simply scan the passoge to get arough idea of what it is about．You will return to the passage for each question，so there isno need to memorize it．O nly spend asmuch time scanning asisnecessary to get avægue impression of itsoverall subject content．100T est 下载频道开通，各类考试题目直接下载。详细请访问 www．100test．com
