The future, we are told, is likely to be different. Detailed surveys of social and economic trends in the European Community show that Europe ' s population is falling and getting older. The birth rate in the Community is now only three-quarters of the level needed to ensure replacement of the existing population. By the year 2020, it is predicted that more than one in four Europeans will be aged 60 or more and barely one in five will be under 20. In a five-year period between 1983 and 1988 the Community ' s female workforce grew by almost six million. As a result, 51% of all women aged 14 to 64 are now economically active in the labour market compared with 78% of men.题目: The rise in the female workforce in the European

Community is a positive trend.分析： 第一步：确定题目中的定位词。本题中的定位词是两个专有名词female workforce

和European Community，专有名词在文章中一般来说不会发生同义转化。而题目中的句子的表语a positive trend则是判断的关键。

第二步. 定位词到原文中定位。原文中的一句话In a five-year period between 1983 and 1988 the Community ' s female workforce grew by almost six million. 同时提到题目中的两个关键词。

而且原文中的grew和题目中的rise构成了同义词转化和词性转化。第三步：原文中的关键词a positive trend在原文的
