reaches the brain more quickly than one swallowed, snorted (such as cocaine powder) or even injected. 题目: Snorted substances reach the brain faster than injected substances. 分析: 题目和原文都有比较, 比较的关键词是 reach the brain faster than, 原文中有一个同义词转换结构 reaches the brain more quickly than。其中 faster 和 more quickly 构成了同义词转换的用法。题目中比较的两方面是 Snorted substances 和 injected substances。而原文的比较内容是 a smoked substance 和 swallowed, snorted (such as cocaine powder) or even injected。题目中的比较对象在原文中是并列关系, 因此无法进行比较, 所以答案判断为 not given。
