One university offers both bachelor 's degrees and master 's degrees. Official say they try to provide students with a social experience as well as an educational one. For example, in some programs, groups of the same six students progress through all their classes together. They communicate by computer. Another online school uses a problem-solving method of teaching. Students attempt to solve real problems in their classes online instead of reading information. Students who have taken online classes say they like them because they do not have to travel to building at a set time to listen to a professor. Professors say they have better communication
