https／／www．100test．com／kao＿ti2020／503／2021＿2022＿＿E8＿B6＿85＿E 8＿B6＿8A 700＿EF＿c86＿503769．htm H aveyou ever wondered what it takesto break the 700 barrier on the GMAT？Thismonth，we will take a look at crossing that increasingly important threshold．O ne of the great GMAT mythsisthat the first 8questionsin each section ＂makeor break＂your score and that nothing you do after that point hasmuch of an effect on the scoreyou end up with．False！Eight questionsare not enough to determineyour score．If they were enough，each section would consist of 8 questions．O ne of the consequences of the myth isthe belief that in order to break 700，you must answer those first 8 questionscorrectly．U ntold numbersof test－takershave labored over the first eight，afraid that any mistake will send their scoresplummeting to unthinkable depths．W hile it is true that you should give each question your best shot，the absolute number of questionsanswered correctly isnot asimportant astheir difficulty level．Better to have a50／50 successrate at a high level than a50／50 success rate at a lower one，even though the percentage of right and wrong answersisthe same．The most seriousupshot of this myth isthat itsbelieversspend far too much timeon the first eight questionsand then find themselves racing to finish the section． O ften，these test－takersrun out of time and leave some questions unanswered at the end of a section．Given that unanswered questions are essentially counted as incorrect answers，it makesmore sense to move at a steady pace throughout the entire section rather than
concentrate on any particular subset of questions．In fact，spending too much time on early questionsmay actually daməge rather than help your final score．Also，keep in mind that even for atest－taker of very high ability，getting the first eight questionscorrect in asection is highly unlikely，even if that test－taker spendsalot of extratime on thosefirst eight questions Remember，due to the adaptive nature of the exam，if you get the first question in asection correct，you will be bumped up to avery difficult second question．If you get that second question right，your third question will also be at an extremely high difficulty level．You will continue to sequestionsat thisvery high difficulty level until you get aquestion wrong，at which point the exam will adjust the difficulty level downward somewhat．Even test－takersof very high ability levelsusually cannot sustain accuracy through the first eight questionsin asection．Do not become avictim of the＂first 8＂myth：give every question your best shot，but do not let any onegroup of questionsdriveyour entire performance．Check in next weeksGMATTERS when we look at the specific numbersyou need in quantitative and verbal to get over the 700 mark．100T est 下载频道开通，各类考试题目直接下载。详细请访问
