The Sunday meat would last until Wednesday and surplus bread and milk became all kinds of cakes. Nothing was wasted and we were never troubled by rotten food. Thirty years on, food deliveries have ceased, fresh vegetables are almost unobtainable in the country. The invention of the fridge contributed comparatively little to the art of food preservation. A vast variety of well-tried techniques already existed -- natural cooling, drying, smoking, salting, sugaring, bottling ... outside, nature provides the desired temperature free of charge. The fridge ' s effect upon the environment has been evident, while its contribution to human happiness has been insignificant.
