S. high court ruling, saying that the governor was" very pleased and gratified. " Mr. Bush wasplanning a nationwide speech aimed at trying to begin to heal the country' sdeep, aching and varied divisions. He then wasexpected to meet with congressional leaders, including Democrats Dick Cheney, Mr. Bush' sruing mate, wasmeeting with congressmen W ednesday in W ashington.W hen Mr. Bush, who is 54 , isssorn into office on Jan. 20 , he will be only the second son of a president to follow hisfather to the W hite H ouse, after John A damsand John Quincy Adamsin the early 19th century.Mr. Gore, in hisspeech, wasexpected to thank hissupporters, defend his

Justice John Paul Stevenswrote in an angry dissent:" Although we may never know with complete certainty the identity of the winner of thisyear' spresidential election, the identity of the loser isperfectly clear. It isthenation' sconfidence in thejudge as an impartial guardian of the law." But at the end of five semingly endlessweeks, during which the physical, legal and constitutional machinesof the U.
