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[https://www.100test.com/kao\\_ti2020/623/2021\\_2022\\_2009\\_E5\\_B9\\_B4\\_E5\\_B7\\_A5\\_c77\\_623879.htm](https://www.100test.com/kao_ti2020/623/2021_2022_2009_E5_B9_B4_E5_B7_A5_c77_623879.htm) 关于缺乏对文章整体理解的问题 #8226.完形填空所选短文一般无标题，文章的第一句话往往是引领全文的主题句，或者引出主题思想的相关内容，是了解文章全貌的“窗口”。#8226.然后，迅速浏览全篇，不为空白处纠缠，捕捉文章的中心。这期间，需要根据上下文，有时还要参照各选项所提供的信息，进行理解。如果是故事性文章，时间、地点、人物就是关键词；抓住了关键词就抓住了故事的线索，就能理解全文。#8226.由于短文中抽空达到10个，失去信息较多，如果考生浏览后不清楚其主题脉络，也不必为此过多担心，至少浏览一遍后有了一个初步印象，为后面做题和逐步理解创造了条件。前面谈到完形填空题要从整体理解，是就命题的初衷而言，也是一种理想的做题方法，要求应试者的英语水平跟得上。而从临场经验和考生得分来看，整体理解只是与一部分题目直接相关，尤其是语义逻辑题，这类题的解题方法，我们在第三节中有专门讨论。#8226.我们以下面一篇试题为例作分析。#8226. 6, inaccurate or indefinite words may make 7 difficult for the listener to understand the 8 which is being transmitted to him.
