对.....感到有愧”。全句的意思为“我们很爱吃，但是往往  
在吃完之后又有负罪感”。 2.M be obsessed with 为固定搭配，  
原意为“被.....附上/缠住/迷住心窍”，放在本句表示“十  
分重视”。全句的意思为“我们很关心健康和减肥，但肥胖

新奇的方法来酗酒”，可以确定I为正确选项。 5. F 本题较难  
。根据be 和by 确定应填入一个过去分词。再根据上下文，上  
文表示“应该吃典型的美国人吃的食物”，下文通过 but 转  
折，表示实际上“美国的食物已经被诸如比萨和热狗这样的  
舶来品所诠释了”，因此可以确定F为正确选项。 6.B政治结

果，可根据宗教原因religious reasons来推断此处填政治结果。

7. L由于横线后面没有宾语，可以确定不是形成bring的短语，这样本句所缺的为一名词，做bring的宾语。根据下文解释，“美国人对他们所吃的食物的态度是矛盾的”，可以推出本句意义为“坚定的观点也不是确定不变的”。因此可以确定L为正确选项。

8. K系动词become后应填入一个形容词，和后面介词of形成短语be/become suspicious of “对……感到怀疑”。

9. J本句缺一个名词作主语，并且根据和介词in的搭配，可以推断出正确选项belief，(have)belief in sth. “相信……”。

10. C本句是一般现在时，缺一个动词，且和with搭配，确定选项为share, share sth. with sb., “与某人分享某事”。
