die, decease, expire, perish, pass away 这些动词或短语动词均有“死”或“死亡”之意。die: 最普通用词，指某人或某物失去生命而永远不存在。He died a millionaire. (他死时是个百万富翁。) decease: 正式用词，多指法律上的用语。Upon his decease the house will pass to his wife. (他死后房屋归他太太所有。) expire: 委婉用词。从本义“从肺部吐出气来”引申为吐出最后一口气，断气而死。He expired at midnight. (他在午夜死去。) perish: 书面用词，多指夭折或不幸暴亡。Hundreds of sheep perished that year because of drought.
